

(Addendum to BAF Advisory#1552, dated 21st Sept 2025 and #1552A of 30th Sep 2025)

Updated: 17th Oct 2025

This document is prepared to assist Management Committees (MCs') and Residents of Member apartments of BAF. This can be used as a ready reckoner.

1. What is the survey all about?

This is an initiative by the Government of Karnataka's via its autonomous Commission. It seeks to collect socio-economic, educational, and occupational data of all citizens across the state. The information gathered will form a foundation for policy decisions, welfare initiatives, and developmental programs. Since the last survey was conducted in 2014–15, this exercise holds importance in capturing the current data and needs of society.

2. Who is conducting the survey?

The survey is led by the Karnataka State Commission for Backward Classes (KSCBC). The commission is taking help from various other departments of the state government to conduct the survey.

3. When will the survey be conducted?

The survey was planned to be conducted between 22nd September 2025 to 7th October 2025. The commission expects to have the survey report by Dec 2025. **For Bengaluru city the survey started on 3rd Oct, and the plan is concluded by 24th Oct 2025.**

4. Who are the Enumerators (Surveyors) for the survey?

The responsibility of the survey is entrusted to Govt School teachers – state and BBMP, ASHA and Anganwadi workers of the area. About 3 lakh staff are deployed to complete the survey in the period of 15 days. Each Enumerator will have up to 150 houses to complete in the survey period.

5. How do I identify the Enumerators?

Each Enumerator has been issued with ID card by the Karnataka State Backward Classes Commission with an identification tag Social Educational Survey 2025. and a letter by District Commissioner. Enumerators shall display one of them.

6. How will the enumerators identify houses?

As a preparatory phase to the survey, all ESCOM meter readers of the state were entrusted with the responsibility of identifying each house and have generated Unique Household Identity number (UHID) based on electricity Revenue Register Number (RR No.). In the process approximately 1.9cr houses have been tagged already. This UHID is specific to this survey.

Please see below a sample sticker that would be already on the doors of the houses or in your apartment.



PS: The Commission requests that the above stickers be kept intact until the survey report is finalized. Hence, please do not remove them even after the survey is completed.

7. Would enumerators be doing door to door survey?

The intention is to cover every household in the survey. Management Committees are requested to facilitate this process. If the MC feels it is more practical to organize the survey in a common area, they may coordinate with the Enumerators to do so. The key objective is to ensure that all households are included in the survey.

8. What are the documents needed for the survey?

Please have all the Aadhar cards and Voter IDs of the household ready. Though you may not be asked to produce the physical IDs, it is needed to have the above numbers handy. The enumerators are expected to enter Aadhar numbers of all the family members and applicable Voter ID information.

8.1 Survey authenticates using Aadhar or Rationcards.


8.2 Please have house electricity bill and voter IDs (if applicable) handy

8.3 In case the household has a Ration card, upon its entry into survey app, some of the data will be preloaded. In case ration card is not available Aadhar card of all the members of the house is needed.

8.4 e-KYC using Aadhar OTP will be needed. e-KYC is for all the family members.

8.5 Other than Aadhar OTP based KYC, survey also accepts Face KYC. Please refer Page 17 and 18 of the guide book :



9. Is it mandatory to have all the family members during the survey?
No. Any one member of the family, who could provide all the details, is sufficient. However the OTP for eKYC based on Aadhar will be needed.
10. What if residents (a household) are not available on the day of the survey?
Enumerators have been instructed to make multiple attempts to reach any households missed during the survey period, ensuring complete coverage.

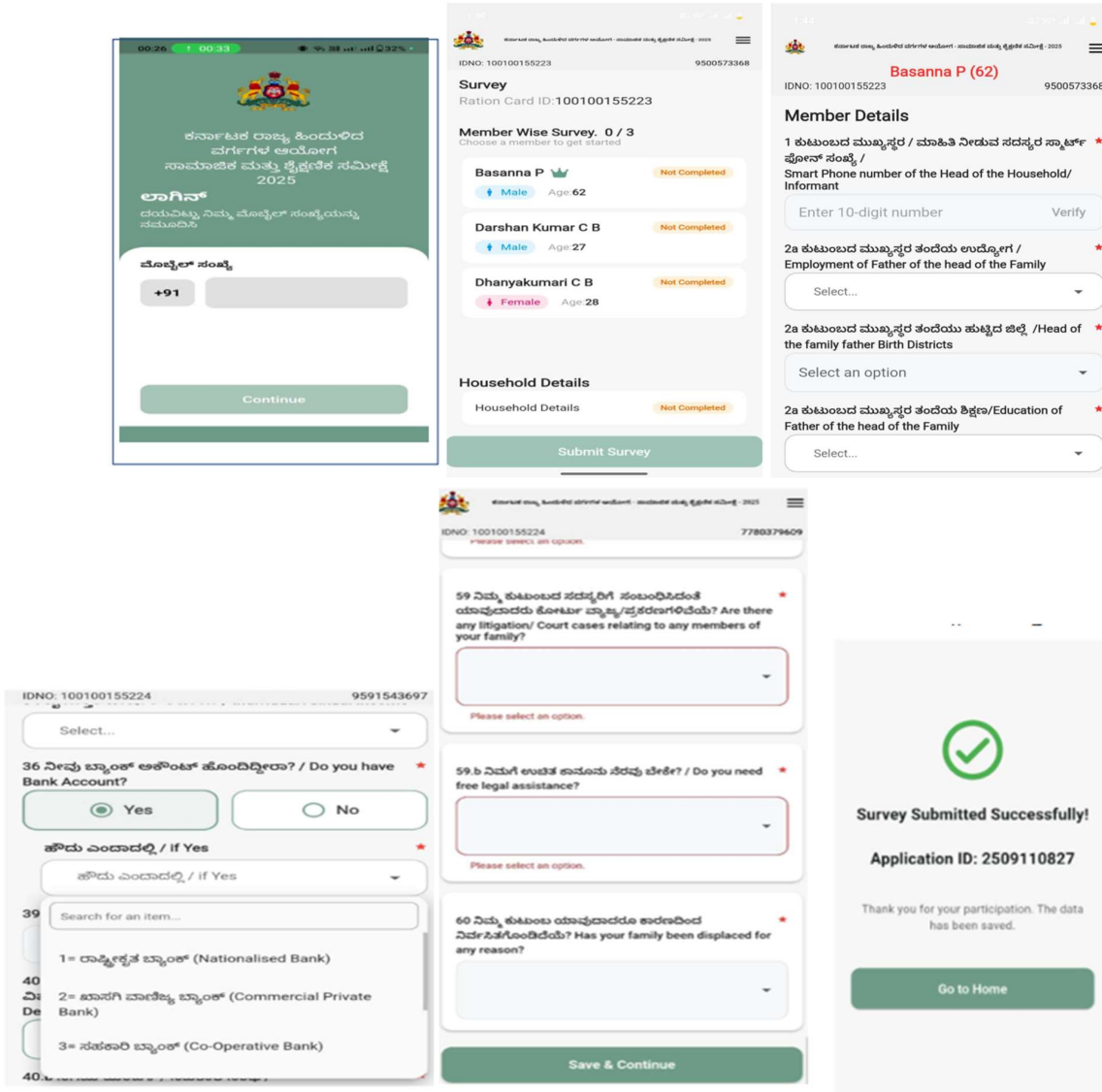

11. Will the Enumerators have a form to conduct the survey OR what is the mode of survey?


The survey will be conducted via Mobile App exclusively developed for this survey, by Directorate of Electronic Delivery of Citizen Services (EDCS), Govt of Karnataka

12. How to know the survey is complete?

At the end of the survey (60 questions), the enumerators will submit the data, an application ID is generated, and you may be asked to sign a self-declaration sheet as below.

13. "Few of houses are not interested in the survey. How to go about it"?

The intention of the survey is to include every home of the state. And Survey intends to capture the data of about 7 Cr people of approx. 2 Cr homes of the state. All the people residing in the state are requested to participate in the survey positively.

If you choose not to participate in the survey, the enumerators will ask you to sign a declaration confirming your decision.

14. "I don't intend to disclose answers to few of the questions"

Goal is to have all the data that will be used to form the social welfare schemes. Therefore, it is recommended to give appropriate answers. However, the answers have options to choose what information you would want to provide. Express your intent to enumerators.
